Nature is central to Elk River's community -- with 45 parks covering almost 1,100 acres, over 75 miles of paved walkways, and a myriad of hiking and biking trails throughout the city. Residents can also take advantage of our Bailey Point Nature Preserve, Elk River Activity Center, Elk River Arena, and annual farmers market, plus adult softball and volleyball leagues.

Being a family-oriented community, Elk River offers a variety of youth programs as well, including preschool tumbling, soccer, flag football, basketball, t-ball, skating, hockey and much, much more.

Hillside Mountain Bike Park

Is home to six miles of challenging mountain bike trails. Volunteers built and maintain these trails, which travel through 80 acres of oak forest.



Elk River Population





over the past 2 decades




GET TO KNOW OUR COMMUNITY

In addition to the District 728 Public Schools, Elk River is home to a number of parochial and charter schools, as well as the Ivan Sand Community High School, an alternative-learning center for grades 8-12.

Higher Education

The City of Elk River also offers a variety of opportunities in higher education, with 19 public and private colleges in the area. Two industry-leading schools of science and engineering — the University of Minnesota and the University of St. Thomas — are just 35 minutes from the city, while the Minnesota School of Business, with degree programs in business management, software application development, and server administration, is near the Downtown District of Elk River.




THE NATURAL CHOICE FOR BUSINESS
